ARTIST BIO:

Ari Glass is an emerging artist and musician from South Seattle. In his paintings he tells a story about the ideas of "The King" and "The Kingdom". ARI deals with concepts and stories of historical and fictional kings, queens and dieties that he feel a personal connection with. The idea is that everyone is a sovereign ruler in their own kingdom. Within this concept is the reason ARI uses his go-to medium: gold leaf. Gold is a traditional element that represents royalty and divinity since before recorded history. ARI

recently had his first solo painting exhibition called "The Sun is Made of Gold" at 2312 Gallery in Seattle. The success from his debut exhibition has lead to the current show at the historic Paramount Theatre in Seattle until May 2016. For his next project will be creating a new music EP, designing clothing for his line REVERIE® as well as merchandise and visuals for the Graffiti Village Tour.
